The list of priorities groups together items of similar intent and filters out redundant items from the collection process. It is not an exhaustive list, and the items contained herein are suggested activities. Members of the workgroups assigned to each area will have the discretion to select which items they work on since it may not be possible to completely cover everything.

Instructions for Ranking Priority Areas

For each group, each member of the COA will be asked to assign a ranking of subjective importance on the following scale:
