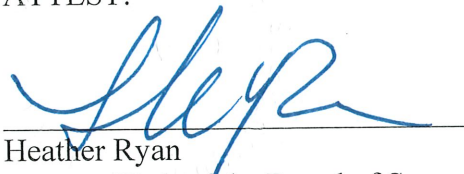

Karen Hopkins, Facilitator, led a conversation with recommendations for communication and reporting on the approved Board Priorities.

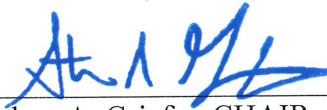
With nothing further to come before the Board, the Tuolumne County Board of Supervisors adjourned their meeting at 2:45 p.m.
