- Sonora Veterans Hall: Steve (maintenance) met with *Deb Esque*

06/02/2026- to keep “high carpet” with Laminate flooring near bar area.

Suggested to keep the flooring in “better shape” and for longer time frame., due to walking and movement of chairs for that location. (TWO feet near bar to match all other flooring throughout the building. Also, needs downstairs dinning. (another tear) to have looked over. (suggesting June 30th) to have flooring done. Needs approval 1st carpet/laminate. In the weeks windows glazing, condition of windows, “Anderson Windows”- windows throughout building. (National Office)

SOUNDPROOF- has “work order” on these. Looking for products to find out the BEST solution. Maybe on “exterior walls.” Still researching for options. Frank

Smart suggested from calls he made many years ago that Roseville Construction, suggested to put in dropped ceiling OR drape curtains that are used for “soundproof” STEVE will investigate/ researching these suggestions, too.

ELECTRIC SIGNS- *Deb Esque*, (3) lights on building LED, for better lighting will do best to blend with building. Brick with two monitors. (Back-to-Back)

Waterproof/all-weather proof, around \$ 1600.00 PLUS screen monitors. Talk with electrician about further prices/estimated breakdown for everything.

Some of the Bathroom lights are/are not working. Still need to be fixed. Upstairs in building, still needs a “walkthrough”: to confirm each section of the building.

- **Tuolumne Memorial Hall:** Steve-Put in a call to James for “*power plush*” to the toilets. Still looking at water line (does this mean this is caused due to the bathroom line OR elsewhere?) New drinking fountain- trees trimmed back. Birds/swallows- suggestions for keeping them away. Has a few ideas-wanted any feedback. In a couple of weeks- sewer line will be starting (May need to rent a lit.) Before June 30th, 2026, to” rap things up! “Will be utilizing jail workers to help with scrapping lead/paint. Lock smith- uploading new keys OR electronic keypad, OR key code. Men’s bathroom lights- “working” needs for Steve to confirm.
